White Center Community Lunch 9 am - 2:15 pm All Ages

Every Saturday, a local group provides a hot lunch to 80 -100 people in Bartell's parking lot. On the Day of Service, one group will prep the food at OLG while another group will serve it to our neighbors in need.

AIDNW (Advocates for Immigrants in Detention NW) Welcome Center Near the NW Detention Center - Tacoma 10:00 am - 3:00 pm All ages

AIDNW Welcome Center offers safe release services along with social and community assimilation support to immigrants upon their release from the NW Detention Center. Volunteers will help assist at the Welcome Center and and learn more about detention issues.

Urban Impact - Seattle 10am - 2 pm All Ages

Urban Impact partnered with people in the neighborhood to address issues surrounding education, youth development, family, health, economic stability and racial reconciliation. Volunteers will help put on a brunch and dine in the Emerald City Commons housing complex where many of the residents are East African immigrants. After lunch, volunteers will help organize a garden craft project with the kids and residents.

VA Puget Sound Fisher House - Seattle 3pm - 7 pm All Ages

Drawing residents from around the world, from various backgrounds, ages and needs, all residents share one thing in common-- love and concern for a hospitalized individual. During Day of Service, volunteers will have the opportunity to spend time in community with this varied group of individuals. Volunteers will help with meal prep, gardening, basic cleaning and various other activities to support residents.

Tri-Parish Food Bank - Burlington 8:30 am - 5:00 pm YOUTH PROJECT

This year, teen and young adult volunteers will venture to St. Charles in Burlington in youth-group style fashion, to help staff the Tri-Parish Food Bank used by migrant workers and others in the area who are experiencing food insecurity. While at St. Charles, volunteers will learn about the realities of migrant life, tour a migrant camp, and spend time with families and children in the migrant community. Like the Youth Migrant Project, offered through the parish for teens during the summer, this one-day project allows young people in our parish to work in communion with one another as the hands and feet of Christ.

Lutheran Community Services

10 am - 2 pm All Ages

Volunteers will help provide welcome and will serve snacks at a Cultural Orientation for refugees who are learning about life in the U.S. The group will stay to hear a little of the orientation, designed with adults in mind, before heading to a LCS warehouse to help assemble Refugee Welcome Kits filled with many essentials ranging from household to personal items.

Santa Teresita - West Seattle

9:30 am - 2 pm Adults only

Santa Teresita is a Catholic Housing Services housing complex for low-income families who are at risk of homelessness. Volunteers will help lead the children and families in a variety of fun craft projects that will help beautify the grounds and common spaces.

Walmesley Center Drop-In (Gym)

9:30am - 2:00 pm (Drop In) All Ages

Join us in the Walmesley Center to work on activities to help support OLG's home-bound and homeless ministries. Volunteers will partake in a variety of tasks, ranging from creating Care Kits, to making rosaries and creating cards and placemats for various organizations.

Books to Prisoners

10am - 2:00pm Ages 15 and up

Books to Prisoners strives to help individuals who are incarcerated by providing tools for education and self-fulfillment. Volunteers will answer request letters for books by locating the books and preparing them to be mailed.

Nature Consortium - West Seattle

10 am - 2 pm All Ages

Nature Consortium is a grassroots, local organization whose mission is to connect people, arts and nature. Volunteers will join Nature Consortium's restoration staff to help remove invasive plants, mulch, and/or plant in a local West Seattle park.

WestSide Baby – White Center

10 am - 2 :00pm Ages 8 and up

WSB partners with over 120 social service agencies to provide children of all ages with clothes, diapers and toys. On the Day of Service, volunteers will tour the facility, get an overview of the program and will sort, file and bundle donations, orders and supplies for children in our community.

Rainier Valley Food Bank

9 am -12 pm or 9 am - 2:30 pm All Ages

Rainier Valley Food Bank is the busiest food bank in all of Seattle in one of the most diverse areas of the city. During Day of Service, volunteers will distribute the food to customers and perform other tasks as needed. This project allows volunteers two different opportunities to volunteer, either as a full shift from 9:00 - 2:30 or a short shift of 9:00– 12:30.
